Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 6B of chapter 231 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 5, the words "at the rate of twelve per
- 3 cent per annum" and inserting in place thereof the following:- calculated at a weekly average 1-
- 4 year constant maturity treasury yield, as published by the Board of Governors of the Federal
- 5 Reserve System, for the calendar week preceding date of the judgment.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 6C of said chapter 231 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is
- 7 hereby amended by striking out, in line 4, the words "at the rate of twelve per cent per annum"
- 8 and inserting in place thereof the following:- calculated at a weekly average 1-year constant
- 9 maturity treasury yield, as published by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System,
- 10 for the calendar week preceding date of the judgment.

- amended by striking out, in line 7, the words "at the rate of twelve per cent annum" and inserting
- in place thereof the following:- calculated as set forth above.
