## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act ensuring affordability in perpetuity.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 40B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after section 21, the following new section:-
- 3 Section 21A. All low or moderate income housing constructed under a comprehensive
- 4 permit must remain affordable in perpetuity.
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
