In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to uniformity in veteran benefits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 115, Section 5 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after paragraph 7, the following:-
- 3 "The Secretary of Veterans' Services shall promulgate regulations ensuring that no
- 4 deposits under three hundred dollars per month may be counted as income for the purposes of
- 5 determining eligibility under MGL, Chapter 115. Nothing herein precludes the Secretary or
- 6 Veterans Service Officers from using this, or any information in bank statements provided to
- 7 them to further their investigation to determine eligibility for benefits under this chapter."
