Department of Public Utilities Energy Facilities Siting Board Trust Fund

Between November 22, 2023, and November 5, 2024, the Department of Public Utilities collected \$0 in revenue and expended \$185,495.06 from the Energy Facilities Siting Board Trust Fund, for an unexpended balance of \$438,970.47.
