## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to rape by an officer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 22 of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:-
- For the purposes of this subsection, "control" shall include, but not be limited to,
- 4 supervising a person under the age of 18 who is in a law enforcement training program;
- 5 interacting with a person being questioned, investigated or detained; communicating the power
- 6 to charge or arrest a person, whether explicitly or implicitly, regardless of whether such power
- 7 could lawfully be exercised; or otherwise exercising or attempting to exercise coercion or
- 8 influence while acting under color of law.
