An Act relative to stroke data reporting.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 126 of the acts of  
2 2022, is hereby amended in section 51L, by inserting after subsection (c), the following  
3 subsection:-

4 (d) The department shall make an annual report of its doings under this section,  
5 including, but not limited to: (i) the current state of pre-hospital care protocols and point-of-entry  
6 plans to ensure stroke patients are transported to the most appropriate facility; (ii) an overview of  
7 the work done by the task force established in subsection (c); (iii) the number of suspected stroke  
8 patients transported directly to a designated stroke facility and the time required to arrive; (iv)  
9 the number of suspected stroke patients transported to a hospital then discharged to a designated  
10 stroke facility and the time required to arrive. Said report shall be filed with the clerks of the

- 11 senate and house of representatives, the joint committee on public health and the joint committee
- 12 on health care financing.
