In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act for primary election reform.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The Massachusetts General Laws are hereby amended by inserting the
- 2 following new chapter:
- 3 An Act for Primary Election Reform.
- 1.) The regular Primary Election Day for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, shall be
 the third Tuesday of May.
- 2.) It is in the interest of public policy, and fair, informed elections, that the General
 Election campaign be, and have the opportunity to, develop over a sustained period of time.
- 3.) Therefore, the practices of many states, have Primaries before the Summer Season,
 and General Elections in the Fall Season, and this is the intent of this legislation, hoping that it
- may increase turnout, and public engagement, in both the primaries, and general elections.

- 4.) The Secretary of the Commonwealth, as the Chief Election Officer, shall have the full
- powers to establish such needed rules, and regulations regarding all elections, as is normal
- practice, that will apply to this May Primary Election Day; including Absentee Ballots, Early
- 14 Voting, Mail-In, and other appropriate provisions.
