Summary



529 savings plans help families save for college, with earnings or contributions not subject to federal taxes.



Under the new plan, individuals may deduct up to \$1,000, and married couples may deduct up to \$2,000.



Massachusetts now joins 33 other states and Washington, DC in allowing deductions in state taxes for 529 plans.




