An Act authorizing the Town of Tyngsborough to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws or any
2 other general or special law to the contrary, the licensing authority of the town of Tyngsborough
3 may grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the
4 premises to Tyngsboro Sports Center, Inc. located at 18 Progress Avenue in the town of
5 Tyngsborough under section 12 of said chapter 138. Said license shall be subject to all of said
6 chapter 138 except said section 17. Notwithstanding any General or special law, or any rule or
7 regulation to the
8 contrary, the local alcohol licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of said license to any other
9 location. Said license may be granted by the local alcohol licensing authority at the same location if an
10 applicant for said license files with said authority a letter in writing from the department of Revenue
11 indicating that said license is in good standing with said Department and that any and all applicable taxes
12 have been paid.

13 If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, such license shall be
14 returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto to the local
15 alcohol licensing authority. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, or any other
16 General or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the local alcohol licensing authority may then
17 grant the license to a new applicant at the same location and under the same conditions as specified in this
18 section.

19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect upon its passage.
