# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

An Act authorizing the town of Milford to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General  
2 Laws, the licensing authority of the town of Milford may grant a license for  
3 the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises to Paul J.  
4 Moffi, of 7 Charles Gate road in the town of Hopedale, Worcester county for  
5 use in connection with premises situated at 134 South Main street in the town  
6 of Milford under section 15 of said chapter 138. The license shall be subject  
7 to all of said chapter 138, except said section 17.

8 The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license to  
9 any other location but it may grant the license to a new applicant at the same  
10 location if the applicant files with the licensing authority a letter from the  
11 department of revenue indicating that the license is in good standing with the  
12 department and that all applicable taxes have been paid.

13 If the license granted under this act is cancelled, revoked or no longer  
14 in use, it shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges  
15 and restrictions pertaining thereto to the licensing authority, which may then  
16 grant the license to a new applicant at the same location under the same

17 conditions as specified under this act.

18           Upon issuance of the license authorized in this act, Paul J. Moffi shall  
19 return to the licensing authority the license he currently holds for the sale of  
20 wines and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect upon its passage.
