An Act relative to the purchase of flags in the commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 6 of chapter 2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking out, in lines 7 to 10, inclusive, the words “; provided, however, that  
3 a flag shall be considered manufactured in the United States if a substantial majority of the  
4 principal components are assembled into the final product in an assembly plant in the United  
5 States”.
