*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 32E, subparagraph (b) of Chapter 94C as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the words “clause (4)
- 3 of paragraph (a)” the following:- “clause (2) of paragraph (c),”.
