An Act relative to age in the Massachusetts retirement system.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Said chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the  
2 following new section:-

3           Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary, for employees who enter  
4 the service of the commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof on or after the effective  
5 date of this section, the minimum age for the receiving of a retirement allowance shall be 62  
6 years of age.
