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The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act relative to the Cotuit Fire District.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws chapter 32B, elected  
2 officials of the Cotuit Fire District who receive a salary or a stipend shall not be eligible for  
3 participation in the District's contributory health and life insurance plan, as soon as applicable or  
4 at the end of their current term, whichever comes first. Elected officials who receive a salary or a  
5 stipend and who elect to pay one hundred percent of the cost of the District health and life  
6 insurance plan may be deemed eligible to so participate. Subject to a vote of the district.
