An act authorizing a ballot question in the town of Arlington relative to the granting of additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 11 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, chapter 28  
2 of the acts of 2006, chapter 83 of the acts of 2010, or any other general or special law to the  
3 contrary, the board of selectmen of the town of Arlington shall cause to be placed on the official  
4 ballot at the 2012 annual town election the following question:

5           “Shall the board of selectmen of the town be authorized to grant up to 2 additional  
6 licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises?”

7           Yes \_\_\_\_\_ No \_\_\_\_\_

8           SECTION 2. If a majority of votes cast in answer to the question is in the affirmative,  
9 the town of Arlington shall be taken to have authorized the granting of up to 2 additional licenses  
10 for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

11          SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
