An Act authorizing the town of Hull to extend the lease of a certain building in the town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. The town of Hull, acting by and through its board of selectmen, and subject to
2 paragraphs (a), (b) and (g) of section 16 of chapter 30B of the general laws, may extend the lease
3 of the property located at 435 Nantasket Avenue, known as the "Scout Building", and shown as
4 plot 24 on assessors map 28 to the current lessees or their assigns and successors, on such terms
5 as the board of selectmen determines to be in the best interests of the town for the benefit of the
6 community.

7 Section 2. Any further disposition of the property or portion of the property described in
8 section 1, including any improvements thereto, shall be subject to section 16 of chapter 30B of
9 the general laws.
