*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           The bridge designated by chapter 46 of the acts of 1971 as the Charles W. Parker, Jr.
- 2 bridge on interstate highway route 195 in the town of Wareham shall be redesignated as the First
- 3 Sergeant Charles W. Parker Memorial Bridge, in memory of Charles W. Parker who was killed
- 4 in action while a member of the armed forces of the United States during World War II. The
- 5 division of highways within the Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 6 maintain suitable markers bearing that designation in compliance with applicable state and
- 7 federal standards.
