

HOUSE No. 3881

By Representative Arciero of Westford and Senator Fargo, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3881) of James Arciero, Susan C. Fargo and others (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Chelmsford to lease a certain parcel of land in said town for agricultural purposes. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act authorizing the town of Chelmsford to lease Sunny Meadow Farm.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Chelmsford, acting through its board of selectmen, may lease
2 for agricultural purposes, for a term or terms not to exceed 10 years, all or a portion of the
3 following parcels of town-owned land acquired for open space purposes:

4 A. Board of Assessors Map 109, Block 421, Lot 32, containing 14 acres, more or
5 less, and further shown as “Lot 4” on a plan of land dated March 7, 1997 prepared by Ludwig
6 Surveying Assoc., Inc., 378 Littleton Road, Westford, Mass., entitled “Compiled Plan of Land in
7 Chelmsford, Mass.”, scale 1” = 100’, which plan is recorded with Middlesex North District
8 Registry of Deeds at Plan Book 197, Plan 104, and described in a deed to the town recorded in
9 Book 22255, Page 37;

10 B. Board of Assessors Map 109, Block 421, Lot 36, containing 8.52 acres, more or
11 less, and further shown as “Lot 5A” (a combination of Lot A and Lot 5) on a plan of land dated
12 October 4, 2000 prepared by Ludwig Surveying Assoc., Inc., 378 Littleton Road, Westford,

13 Mass. entitled, "Compiled Plan of Land in Chelmsford, Massachusetts," scale 1" = 50', which
14 plan is recorded with the Middlesex North District Registry of Deeds at Plan Book 204, Plan 51,
15 and described in a deed to the town recorded in Book 22255, Page 45.

16 SECTION 2. The leases authorized hereunder shall be subject to all other applicable
17 provisions of law, including chapter 30B of the general laws.

18 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
