Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding and general or special law to the contrary, Chapter 18B of
- 2 the Mass General Laws is amended by adding Section 23: "the Department of Children and
- 3 Families is precluded from spending any state dollars on Family Networks contacts, so called,
- 4 and all cost savings utilized from the cancellation of such contracts shall be used to hire
- 5 additional social workers and supervisors including cost such as additional manager, desks,
- 6 computers, etc.
