An Act relative to the statewide head injury program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 78 of chapter 6 of the General Laws as most recently  
2 appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end of paragraph (2)  
3 the following new paragraph:-

4                   (3) The commission shall, subject to appropriations, develop and provide,  
5 either directly or through purchase of service, such services as deemed necessary and appropriate  
6 to persons with acquired brain injuries. Such services will be managed by the statewide head  
7 injury program and delivered to persons meeting the eligibility requirements for each such  
8 service.
