An Act relative to public employees serving in the armed forces of the United States.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 137 of the acts of 2003, is hereby amended by striking  
2 out the section in its entirety.
