Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, The
2 Department of Conservation and Recreation within the Executive Office of Environmental
3 Affairs will issue a public bid for the privatization of the Ponkapoag golf course, located in
4 Canton and the Leo J. Martin golf course, located in Weston. All funds will be directed to the
5 Department of Conservation and Recreation.
