**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Nena Canada, an employee of the Trial Court.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Trial Court, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, the Trial Court shall establish a sick leave bank for Nena Canada, an employee of the  
3 Trial Court. Any employee of the Trial Court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,  
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for the use by Nena Canada. Whenever Nena  
5 Canada terminates employment with said department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank,  
6 the balance of the sick leave bank time shall be transferred to the trial court paid sick leave bank.  
7 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that  
8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Trial Court.
