An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Theodore Laridis.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to make to immediately establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Transportation, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule or regulation to  
2 the contrary, the Department of Transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Theodore  
3 Laridis, an employee of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily  
4 contribute one or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Theodore  
5 Laridis. Whenever Theodore Laridis terminates employment with the department or requests to  
6 dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the  
7 Department of Transportation extended sick leave bank. Sick leave bank days may not be used  
8 for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick  
9 leave bank as determined by the department.
