An act establishing a sick leave bank for Maria Conlon, an employee of the registry division of the Division of Transportation.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the registry division of the department of transportation, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the registry  
2 division of the department of transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Maria Conlon,  
3 an employee of the registry division of the department. Any employee of the department may  
4 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by  
5 Maria Conlon. Whenever Maria Conlon terminates employment with the department or requests  
6 to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to  
7 the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to  
8 the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined  
9 by the department
