An Act increasing penalties for driving without a license or registration..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2008 official edition, is hereby amended in line 10 by striking the words “of not less than one
3 hundred nor more than two hundred dollars” and further amended by inserting in place thereof
4 the following:- of five hundred dollars for a first offense, by a fine of not less than five hundred
5 nor more than one thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not more than ten days, or both, for a
6 second offense, by a fine of not less than one thousand nor more than two thousand dollars or by
7 imprisonment for not more than thirty days, or both, for any subsequent offense.
