## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act providing for home health care & hospice tax deductions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-
- 3 (m)(1) A taxpayer who pays for direct home health services for an elderly parent or in
- 4 law 60 years of age or older who resides in the commonwealth shall be allowed a deduction of
- 5 \$1500. (2) A taxpayer who pays for his own home health care services shall be allowed a
- 6 deduction of \$1500. (3) A taxpayer who pays for direct home hospice services for another shall
- 7 be allowed a deduction of \$1500.
