Resolve providing for an investigation and study by a special commission relative to child suicide.

1 Resolved, SECTION 1. Resolved, that a special commission to consist of 11 members: 3
2 members of the senate; 1 of whom shall be a member of the joint committee on education; 1 of
3 whom shall be a member of the joint committee on mental health and substance abuse; 1 of
4 whom shall be a member of the senate; provided, however, that 1 member of the senate shall be
5 designated as co-chair of the commission; 3 members of the house of representatives; 1 of whom
6 shall be a member of the joint committee on education, 1 of whom shall be a member of the joint
7 committee on mental health; 1 of whom shall be a member of the house of representatives;
8 provided, however, that 1 member of the house of representatives shall be designated as co-chair
9 of the commission; 1 of whom shall be the commissioner of elementary and secondary
10 education, or his designee; 1 of whom shall be the commissioner of mental health, or his
11 designee; and 3 members to be appointed by the governor, 1 of whom shall be a member of the
12 Massachusetts Association of School Superintendents, 1 of whom shall be a member of the
13 mental health advisory council established under section 11 chapter 19 of the General Laws, and
14 1 of whom shall be an advocate for pediatric early childhood mental health, is hereby established
15 for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to strategies for suicide prevention
16 and the resources necessary to assist elementary and secondary schools identify and assist
17 children at risk. The commission shall report to the general court the results of its investigation
18 and study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
19 out such recommendations, by filing the same with the clerks of the senate and the house and
20 who shall forward the same to the chairs of the joint committee on education and the chairs of
21 the joint committee on mental health and substance abuse and the chairs of the joint committee
22 on children, families and persons with disabilities and the chairs of the house and senate
23 committees on ways and means on or before December 31, 2014.
