#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to posting employment opportunities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 151A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 official
- 2 edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 63 the following new section: Section 63A.
- 3 Every agency, authority and institution of the commonwealth shall transmit to the commissioner
- 4 all employment opportunity notices and postings, including, but not limited to, notices of job
- 5 opportunities, new positions and vacancies. The commissioner shall immediately place all such
- 6 information in the statewide employment computerized referral system and in the printed
- 7 periodic bulletin. No position shall be filled without full compliance with this section.
