Bill Number: H.3641

Bill Name: An Act relative to educational requirements for class 2 motor vehicles

Sponsor(s): Rep. Rob Consalvo

Hearing Date: May 13th, 2025 (**Reporting Date:** July 12th, 2025)

Current Law: Chapter 140 §58; Requirements for a license to sell motor vehicles, with Class 2 licenses pertaining to used motor vehicle sales.

**Summary of
Proposed Law:**

§1 Requires individuals seeking a license to sell used cars to undergo eight hours of educational training from an organization certified by the National Independent Automobile Dealers Association (NIADA.)

Stipulates that the minimum core curriculum shall be determined by the NIADA, in consultation with the Massachusetts Independent Automobile Association, in addition to establishing a standardized exam and certificate of completion for such courses.

Prohibits municipalities from issuing a license to sell used cars unless the applicant produces a certificate proving completion of such an educational course.

Requires licensees to complete four hours of continuing education every two years.

§2 Establishes an effective date for the legislation of January 1st, 2027.
