S.2269 was enacted (Chapter 276 of the Acts of 2018.)

Current Law: Amends MGL Chapter 140 §62. Chapter 140 58 defines the classes of auto dealers, “Class 1” pertaining to auto dealers whose primary business is selling new motor vehicles with incidental used vehicle sales.

**Summary of
Proposed Law:**

§1 Deems Class 1 auto dealers in compliance with requirements to keep a book with data pertaining to used motor vehicle or motor vehicle part sales to the extent that they maintain an “electronic data management system, in a form and in a format approved by the registrar.”
