Current Law: No section in Chapter 175 of General Laws of Massachusetts

Summary: The following will not be considered a surchargeable incident in car insurance.

- Property damage <\$5000
- 1st accident of >\$5000 if only property damage
- First 2 speeding violations, unless a violation could result in license being revoked or suspended
- Any accident caused by a driver, not named on the policy or who isn't from that household
- The 1st or 2nd accident if insured wasn't convicted of a moving violation or wasn't at fault
- Any vehicle infraction
