TITLE An Act relative to the annual street listing

SPONSORS Senator Collins

SUMMARY

Currently, if a resident fails to respond to a mailing from a city or town for 2 consecutive years, it results in the removal of that resident's name from the city or towns voter list. By removing the words "for 2 consecutive years" from subsection (c) of Section 4 of Chapter 51, this bill would make any failure to respond result in the removal of that resident's name from the voting list.
