SENATE BILL: None

CURRENT LAW: The Child Labor Amendment is a pending amendment to the United States Constitution that would grant congress the power to regulate labor by people under 18 years old. Passed by the U.S. House and Senate in 1924, the requisite $\frac{3}{4}$ s of states have not ratified it.

BILL SUMMARY: Section 1 – Ratifies the Child Labor Amendment in congruence with the U.S. Constitutional standards for a state to do so.
