**Bill Name:** An Act definition and requirements of motorized vehicle

**Current Law:** Amends MGL Chapter 85 §11B<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and Chapter 90 §1E and §34J.

**Summary of  
Proposed Law:**

- §1** Requires MassDOT to promulgate regulations relative to the registration and insurance of e-bikes and motorized scooters, inclusive of electric or motorized battery powered vehicles that can travel in excess of 30mph.
- §2** Requires a purchaser of an electric bicycle to comply with RMV registration requirements within 10 days of purchase.
- §3** Prohibits the operation of a motorized scooter by any person who does not possess a valid driver's license or learners permit, or by any person who has not obtained a registration for the scooter.
- Limits the operation of a motorized scooter to speeds of under 20 mph.
- §4** Expands existing state law imposing penalties for the operation of a motor vehicle without insurance to also encompass operators of electric bicycles, motorized scooters, or any electric or battery powered device that can be driven or ridden at speeds exceeding 20 mph.
