**Summary:**

SECTION 1 establishes an 11-member special commission to study the effectiveness of the executive office of health and human services (EOHHS). The commission will evaluate the number of employees at EOHHS, the administrative structure of the office, and EOHHS' effectiveness at meeting its legislative mandate. The commission must also consider the feasibility of and potential effectiveness of reconfiguring EOHHS, including dividing the office into smaller subagencies.

SECTION 2 states that the commission will file a report of its findings, including legislative and regulatory recommendations, with the clerks of the house of representatives and the senate, the joint committee on health care financing and the joint committee on public health, by October 1, 2026.
