**Current Law:** Amends MGL Chapter 90 §32G, regarding driving schools.

**Summary of  
Proposed Law:**

- §1** Authorizes the registrar to approve a driver education curriculum presented by a virtual instructor by a driving school licensed by the Commonwealth if the following conditions are met:
- The driving school owns or leases a physical office or classroom within the Commonwealth to provide in-person instruction;
  - The driving school has no less than three consecutive years of operation within the commonwealth; and
  - The driving school is in good standing with the RMV.
