**Summary of  
Proposed Law:**

§1 Waives the reinstatement fee for a license that was suspended or revoked due to violations of Chapter 90 §22 subsection (e), §22F, §23, §24, §24B, §24D, §24G, §24L, or §34J or of Ch. 266 §28 if the licensee was not convicted, placed on probation, or otherwise plead guilty or admitted to a finding of sufficient facts.
