Title: *An Act increasing the age limit for retired police officers serving as special police officers in the town of Weston*

Prior History:

2023-24 (H.4987): Reported favorably; New draft H.5127; Referred to House Steering; Placed in the Orders of the Day; Read second and ordered to a third reading; Read third and engrossed; Senate read and placed in the Orders of the Day

CURRENT LAW:

Chapter 74 of the Acts of 2020: The town manager of the town of Weston may appoint retired Weston police officers at the recommendation of the police chief to perform police details. The maximum age to perform police details is 65 years.

SUMMARY:

The bill amends chapter 74 of the Acts of 2020 by increasing the maximum age for retired Weston police officers to perform detail work from 65 to 70 years.
