## Massachusetts House of Representatives Bill Summary

**Title**: An Act to hold property owners accountable for recurring public

nuisance

**Prior History:** Refile of H.2026 (Study Order H.4573)

**Current Law**: Many General Laws concern various types of nuisances. In this

context, some provisions of Chapter 272 may apply as that chapter deals with crimes committed by individuals against good order.

**Summary:** Section 1 prescribes accountability for property owners who face

multiple public nuisance complaints. This section states that a property owner will be responsible for the costs associated with any additional police calls and other costs incurred by the police department and/or municipality following 10 police calls regarding complaints from or

involving a specific location over a period of 1 year.

Section 2 holds that any funds collected from property owners in

Section 1 of this legislation shall go to the municipality.

Section 3 states that the enforcement of this legislation is at the discretion of the Chief of Police or another municipal authority where

the property is located.
