Current Law: Chapter 40 Section 21(3) of MGL lists the purposes for which cities

and towns may adopt ordinances and by-laws. Subsection (3) allows them to regulate the removal of snow and ice from sidewalks within the limits of public ways, and to impose penalties for violations upon the owner of abutting property, or their agent having care of the property.

Summary: This legislation amends Section 21(3) of Chapter 40 by inserting

language stating that municipal by-laws or ordinances regulating the removal of snow and ice from sidewalks within the limits of public ways shall apply to sidewalks abutting privately-owned property within the

state highway system of the Massachusetts Department of

Transportation and the parkways and public ways of the Department of Conservation and Recreation, unless such by-laws or ordinances are clearly inconsistent with a rule or regulation promulgated by either of such departments. Municipalities may enforce such ordinances and by-laws if they share the revenue with the parties through a memorandum

of understanding.
