TITLE: An Act relative to s-license compliance

PRIOR HISTORY: 2019-2020: H.2842 heard by committee; reported favorably; referred to House Steering, Policy, & Scheduling; no further action taken.

2021-2022: H.3295 heard by committee; reported favorably; referred to House Steering, Policy and Scheduling; ordered to be placed on the Orders of the Day for a second reading; no further action taken

CURRENT LAW:
M.G.L. chapter 147 section 57 concerns the installation, repair, and maintenance of security systems, as well as establishing a licensure requirement for such work.

SUMMARY:
This bill establishes that any bid or proposal for the installation, repair, or maintenance of security systems submitted by a person, firm, or corporation not in compliance with the licensure requirements is deemed invalid.
