**TITLE:** An Act promoting the proper disposal of miniatures.

2017-2018: H.3528 referred to TUE, reported favorably to committee on W&M; no further action taken.

**CURRENT LAW:**

Section 321 of Chapter 94 contains the definitions for the Bottle Bill.

**SUMMARY:**

This legislation adds “miniatures” to the bottle bill. A miniature beverage is in a container that has a capacity of under 100 milliliters that was made to contain an alcohol beverage. Such miniatures shall be subject to a 5 cent bottle deposit in the Commonwealth.
