SUMMARY:

Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the bill mandates a special commission to study and provide recommendations on the feasibility of eliminating gasoline-focused sales-below-cost (SBC) laws for all gasoline station fuel sales in Massachusetts.

The commission shall consist of the Eco Dev Chairs, the Speaker, the Senate President, the minority leaders, and 4 experts in the economics of industrial organization, consumer welfare, and statistical methodologies. They shall report their findings and recommendations within 12 months of bill passage.
