TITLE An Act relative to the Lanesborough Select Board

SPONSORS Representative Barrett of North Adams

CURRENT LAW

Chapter 41 Section 1 of MGL provides for a town to elect a board of selectmen, composed of 3 or more members, to serve terms of up to 3 years.

While various parts of the Lanesborough Bylaws refer to the Select Board, no section specifically deals with the size of the Board.

SUMMARY

Section 1 increases the number of members on the Lanesborough Select Board from three to five, with a chairperson within the Board to be elected from its members following Town Election.

Section 2 states that, at the first Town Election following passage of this bill, three members shall be elected. The top vote-getter will serve a term of three years, the second most vote-getter two years, and the third most one year, creating staggered terms of office. Thereafter, all members will serve terms of three years.

Section 3 states that this act will take effect immediately upon passage.

Language for this act was approved at the June 11, 2024 Lanesborough Town Meeting by a vote of 75 yeas to 25 nays.
