## Massachusetts House of Representatives Bill Summary

**Bill #**: H.4716

**Title**: An Act amending the charter of the city of Pittsfield

**Sponsor**: Rep. Tricia Farley-Bouvier

**Committee**: Municipalities and Regional Government

**Hearing Date:** November 17 – November 21, 2025 written testimony only

**Current Law**: Currently the Pittsfield city charter provides for an 11-member city

council whose members serve two-year terms, and a 7-member school committee. The six elected school committee members serve two-year terms. The seventh member of the school committee is the mayor, who

under a separate charter provision serves a four-year term of office.

**Summary:** Section 1 of the bill amends section 2-1 of article 2 of the city

charter by increasing the term of office for members of the city council

from two years to four years.

Section 2 amends section 4-1 of article 4 of the city charter by

increasing the term of office for members of the school committee from

two years to four years.

These changes will align the terms of office with that of the mayor.

**Notes:** Language adopted by the Pittsfield City Council on August 12, 2025.

The provision relating to school committee members passed by a vote

of 10 in favor and 1 opposed, while the provision relating to the city

council passed by a vote of 8 in favor and 3 opposed.

Approved by the mayor on August 13, 2025.
