Name: An Act to ensure access to medical parole

Summary:

The act defines the state of terminal disease required for medical parole. Upon petition of a prisoner or authorized representative, and supported proper medical diagnosis, a prisoner may be eligible for medical parole if they pose no risk of violence.
