Summary:

Amending MGL Chapter 127 section 133F for parole hearings for persons over the age of 55 who have served 15 years or 50% of their sentence. Considerations for parole to be expanded to include age, long term confinement, diminished capacity, and accommodations for diminished capacity.

The specifications of voting and decision reporting is covered in several sections including an annual report on this category by the parole board to the legislature, including the approved, denied and returned to custody after release.
