CURRENT LAW

Chapter 112 of the General Laws regulates professional licenses and occupations in the Commonwealth.

Section 55 of said chapter governs the examination, registration, and fees of veterinarians' licensure; as well as renewal of licenses and revocation.

SUMMARY

This legislation seeks to amend section 55 of Chapter 112 to modify the professional licensure requirements for veterinarians. Said modifications include: (i) moving the registration process from an annual one to bi-annually (i.e. every two years); (ii) moving the board's requirement to provide license renewal applications and the deadline for fee payment from March to January; (iii) providing for gender neutrality in the statute text; and (iv) changing "mailed" to "transmitted" as it pertains to the board's providing of license renewal applications to registered veterinarians.
