## **PRIOR HISTORY**

(2019-2020): H3827 – Bill reported favorably as redraft, see H4458, by Committee and referred to the committee on House Ways and Means.

(2021-2022): H4238 - Committee recommended bill ought to pass and referred to the committee on House Ways and Means.

(2023-2024): H5147 – Reported from House Ways and Means (new draft of H274); House passed to be engrossed; referred to the committee on Senate Ways and Means.

## **CURRENT LAW**

Sections 252 to 258, inclusive, of chapter 112 of the General Laws govern the licensure and practices of genetic counselors.

## **SUMMARY**

This legislation seeks to amend the existing governing statutes for the licensure and practice of genetic counselors by: updating the names of the national certification agency and accreditation council; redefining and modernizing the acts that constitute the "practice of genetic counseling"; and shortening the length of time for a valid provisional license from 2 years to 1 year intervals.
